## **ATV's Drivers Under 12**

At their March 29, 2007 meeting, the Board of Directors adopted Minnesota State Laws regarding the operation of ATV's for Pathfinder Village. The new policy will not allow anyone under of the age of 12 to operate any type of ATV within Pathfinder Village. This will include the operation of ATV's 90cc and less. This policy was adopted to ensure the safety of these young drivers. Requirements for individuals 12 and older are outlined in this Gazette under ATV Requirements.

Just a reminder that Association Dues for 2007 are \$735.00. The discount of \$100.00 is allowed if paid by the May 1st deadline. If dues are not paid by May 1st, the discount will not apply.

### Mandatory Safety Training for ATV's, Golf Carts and Motorbikes

Safety training is required for all unlicensed individuals under the age of 16 who would like to operate ATV's, golf carts or motorbikes within Pathfinder Village. Class dates for the 2007 season are:

- Sunday, May 20
- Sunday, June 3
- Sunday, June 17
- Sunday, July 1

Time and location to be determined. Please pre-register for these classes at the Park Office. Individuals that went through the entire 2006 season without having any violations do not need to take the safety class for 2007. They will however, need to take the annual test that will cover the rules and regulations pertaining to the operation of these motorized vehicles which must be completed and signed by the lot owner before a renewal sticker will be issued. Your ID card MUST be current for 2007 BEFORE you begin driving. The test is available at the Park Office or online at [www.pathfindervillage.net](http://www.pathfindervillage.net) beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>. Again this year ALL ATV's must be licensed through the DNR\ State of Minnesota. This is a requirement that was adopted by the State of MN in 2004.

*Please be aware that individuals participating in the safety course must be able to operate all controls and pedals while firmly seated on the seat of the vehicle that they will be operating. Any individual that cannot operate the vehicle properly will not be allowed to operate ANY vehicle within Pathfinder. A parent or guardian must also attend the safety class with their child.*

### ELECTRIC METERS WERE READ

Electric meters were read and bills will be sent out with this newsletter. If you do not receive a bill, and think that you should have, or have a question about your bill, please contact the office. The kilowatt rate is .081 cents per kilowatt.

Some information for you to know:

- ① Billing criteria is 54 kw used during the usage period or a minimum bill of \$5.00 if you have a previous balance.
- ② Bills are due and payable to Pathfinder Village upon receipt.
- ③ Bills not paid in 45 days are subject to \$5.00 billing fee.
- ④ Payments are due in the Administration Office on the 28<sup>th</sup> of each month to avoid further billing and finance charges.
- ⑤ Once applied, finance charges and billing fees are not removed from the account.
- ⑥ Subsequent billings are subject to 1.5% finance charge per month on the unpaid balance.
- ⑦ Lot owners who fail to pay their electric bills will have their meters disconnected. In order to have service restored they will be responsible to pay a \$75.00 disconnection/ connection fee in addition to the existing bill.
- ⑧ Pathfinder Village is not responsible for late payments due to mail service.

### Dryland Marina

The Board of Directors recently approved price increases for spaces within the Dryland Marina. The annual fees effective May 1, 2007 are \$100.00 for the normal 12 x 24 spot. Larger storage containers / buildings will be billed at \$0.347 cents per square foot. (Example: a 40 foot storage trailer would be billed at 40x12, or 480 square feet x .347 = \$166.56).

The Board of Directors has also adopted new standards for the Dryland Marina. These standards will be enforced beginning June 1, 2007. Please ensure that your personal property is in compliance by June 1, 2007. These standards will include:

- No Hazardous Materials
- Motorized Vehicles must be in working order and currently licensed.
- Utility Trailers must be working order and currently licensed.
- Watercraft must be resting on appropriate trailers and both must be in working order and properly licensed.
- Travel & Tent Trailers must be in working order and properly licensed.
- Storage Facilities must be secure and be properly maintained.

### Moving / Replacing Trailer

The Board of Directors recently approved a resolution that requires all lot owners to have their trailer placement checked by the Association if they are replacing, or moving an existing trailer.

The goal of the resolution is to ensure the trailer is located within the property lines of the lot. Please contact the Park Office prior to the move so a time can be scheduled to inspect the location. There will be no fee charged for this service.

### Trailer Review Guidelines

The Board of Directors is currently working on updating the inspection process and forms used to complete the trailer inspections. The current Rules and Regulations require all trailers twenty years old or more must be inspected prior to being sold. The inspection is required only if the trailer is going to remain in Pathfinder Village once the lot is sold. Please contact the Park Office or Sales Office prior to listing the property so that an inspection can be scheduled. There is no fee charged for this service.

### Selling Your Lot?

The Board of Directors recently approved a resolution that requires all owners selling their lots to secure a "Data For Sale Permit". This permit is required for all lot owners selling their lots privately or through a real estate broker. The permit will be used to verify that all personal property is located within the lot lines and conforms with the Rules and Regulations. The goal of this resolution is to correct the numerous lot violations prior to the sale. There will be a \$35.00 fee for the inspection. Please also remember if you use an outside realtor to sell your property, the realtor needs to physically show the property at Pathfinder.

### Residential Use

The moratorium will expire May 27,2007. The Board of Directors has decided not to pursue any further action on residential use at this time.

## Firewise Update

The Association has been working jointly with the Department of Natural Resources, Forestry Department, Pine County Emergency Manager, and Hinckley Fire Department to establish an overall assessment of fire hazards within Pathfinder. The initial assessment was completed with the following recommendations:

1. Remove existing fuels (dead brush, dead/diseased trees and prune all trees a minimum of 18 inches from the ground.)
2. Establish evacuation areas for residents within PV.
3. Establish and maintain additional emergency entrances/exits for emergency vehicles.
4. Establish and maintain fire line boundaries between Pathfinder Village and St. Croix State Park.
5. Install and maintain 2 dry hydrants that are accessible for the DNR and Hinckley Fire Department.
6. Provide ongoing education/information regarding emergency evaluation to the owners/guests of Pathfinder Village.
7. Maintain roadways with a minimum clearance of 12 feet wide/16 feet high.

Within the past few months, existing fuels have begun to be removed from the Guest Sites and surrounding 11<sup>th</sup> Addition. This process is expected to continue throughout the park this spring and includes removing dead/diseased trees along with thinning out smaller trees that cannot grow amongst larger healthier trees.

During this process, every effort is being made to preserve each tree within your area. Please be assured that if a tree was removed from your lot or surrounding area, it was removed for a reason.

As the Firewise project continues, small tractors will need to work in and around your property. As these vehicles work, they will try their best not to disturb or damage any personal property such as decorative lights, gravel or decorative rock. Please be assured any damage to decorative lights will be reimbursed by Pathfinder and any disturbance of gravel or rock will be corrected later this spring.

The fire ban has been implemented due to the lack of water in the park. If a fire started in Pathfinder, it would take the Hinckley Fire Department 15 to 20 minutes to get to Pathfinder! The MN Department of Natural Resources also has county wide fire bans in place for the same time frame. ## Trash/Recycling

The Board of Directors has recently authorized two roll-offs per month for owners to use for lot clean-up. In 2006 the Association spent roughly \$9000.00 for these roll-offs. Our goal this year to cut this expense in half and monitor this collection process closer. The roll-off is for items from inside Pathfinder Village ONLY, NOT items brought from home. If you do any demolition at your lot, you will need to get your own demolition roll-off. The roll-off will be accessible during compactor hours.

The following Items that are NOT ALLOWED in the roll-off, compactor or recycling center, and must be brought to the Transfer Station south of Hinckley on Highway 61. Please be advised that you must be an owner at Pathfinder Village to dispose of items at this Transfer Station.

- Refrigerators
- Mattresses / Box Springs
- Tires, or Tire Rims
- Sofas / Hide a beds
- Stuffed Chairs
- Chemicals - Hazardous materials
- TV's or Computer Monitors
- Tubs
- Carpet
- Paint / Stain or Paint / Stain Cans

These items can be disposed of in Pathfinder Village if you follow the requirements:

- Used Motor Oil - \* Contact Pathfinder Village Maintenance
- Grass / Leaves / Branches / Stumps - \* Place in the burn pile without plastic bags.
- Batteries - \* Contact Ala- Cart personally for disposal, do not leave outside shop.
